ABOUT THE CATERAN YOMP

- The Cateran Yomp is one of the Army Benevolent Fund's flagship fundraising events, and the largest event of its kind in Scotland.
- The Yomp – military slang for a long-distance march – is an epic adventure challenge. Over 1,200 participants aim to take on 54 miles in 24 hours across the rugged Scottish terrain.
- The event attracts the finest, most inspirational Yompers from across Scotland, and the world - pushing both their mental and physical limits.
- It raises vital funds for the Army Benevolent Fund, supporting our soldiers, veterans and their families in times of need.

DATE:	7-8 June 2025
LOCATION:	Blairgowrie, Perthshire PH10 6QU
REGISTRATION FEE:	Early-early bird: ends 30th November £75 (military) and £85 (individual), Early bird: 28th February - £89 (military) and £99 (individual), then after 28th Feb – £125 (military) and £135 (individual). Covers food, drink & camping

THE CHALLENGE

A demanding challenge event that caters for all fitness levels with three tiers of difficulty – 54 (Gold), 36 (Silver) or 22 miles (Bronze).

ON THE DAY SUPPORT

Situated along the route are three checkpoints and seven waterstops where teams are refuelled by delicious, locally-produced hot food, snacks and drinks, given a massage and have access to the highest quality medical and marshal support as well as dedicated footcare from the Pod Squad.

Starting with the pre-event Friday night feast, the route features surprise activities and a breath-taking firework display.

- Dedicated branded marquees at the checkpoints for the team
